

**ANG PERSONNEL MOBILIZED: WARS AND MAJOR  
CONTINGENCIES: 1916-1999**

<b>EVENT (Years)</b>	<b>PERSONNEL MOBILIZED</b>	<b>COMMENTS</b>
Mexican Border Crisis (1916)	Appx. 70	Trained at Mineola, New York. Did not serve on Mexican border.
World War I (1917-1918)	Total unknown	Individuals volunteered for aviation service. Most had to leave the Guard.
World War II (1940-1945)	4,800	All 29 observation squadrons mobilized. Members served mainly as individuals in Army Air Forces units.
Korean War (1950-1953)	45,594	80 percent of the force was mobilized. 6 fighter units served in combat. Many individual ANG pilots flew in USAF units including 4 aces.
Berlin Crisis (1961-1962)	21,067	11 fighter squadrons deployed to Europe. 6 heavy airlift squadrons mobilized.
Vietnam War (1968-1969)	10,676	4 fighter units sent to Vietnam and 2 deployed to Korea.
Persian Gulf Crisis (1990-1991)	10,456	A total of 12,404 Air Guardsmen served including volunteers.
Bosnia Peacekeeping (1996-1999)	Over 200	Elements of at least 8 Air Traffic Control & Combat Com units mobilized.
Kosovo Conflict (1999)	3,266 (plus appx. 553 vols)	Mobilized elements of 9 ARWs, 3 FWs, 3 Combat Control Gps, 6 Combat Com Sqds, 3 Air Control Sqds, 3 ATC Sqds, 3 Intell Sqds, & 29 Wx units. .
Operation Southern Watch (1999)	Appx 170 (158 Deployed)	Personnel from 106 RQW, 129 RQW, & 255 <sup>th</sup> ACS deployed to Persian Gulf during Kosovo conflict as backfill for USAF personnel.
